Executive Summary:

The [Municipal Act, 2001](#) authorizes a municipality to impose fees for services. Fees charged to users for various services are a primary source of municipal revenue, representing approximately 15% of the City's total municipal revenue budget. The purpose of this report is to recommend that Council pass a new by-law to establish the fees and charges for the 2026 fiscal year.

In most cases, services that have fees associated with them are also subsidized in various proportions by taxation revenues. Therefore, it is important that fee adjustments are reviewed on an annual basis and in conjunction with a review of respective service costs to ensure that the proportion of user fees and taxation subsidy is maintained and related service costs are appropriately recovered. If fees are not adjusted appropriately, the result will be increased pressure on tax increases to subsidize the costs of providing the service.

As part of the annual budget process, Financial Services reviews, in conjunction with City departments, all fees and charges to ensure that they are being applied in accordance with policy and strategic direction. Respective revenues will be incorporated into the Mayor's 2026 operating budget based on the fees and charges established for 2026.

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It is recommended that Council give three readings to the “A By-Law to repeal City of Kingston By-Law Number 2025-06, "Fees & Charges By-Law, 2025" in its entirety, and to establish “Fees & Charges By-Law, 2026” as presented in Exhibit A.

Recommendation:

That the by-law attached to Report Number 26-003 as Exhibit A, entitled “A By-Law to repeal City of Kingston By-Law Number 2025-06, "Fees & Charges By-Law, 2025" in its entirety, and to establish “Fees & Charges By-Law, 2026”, be presented to Council for all three readings to establish the fees and charges for the 2026 fiscal year.

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Options/Discussion:**Background**

City of Kingston [By-Law Number 2025-6](#) "Fees and Charges By-Law, 2025" provided for adjustments to fees for services and expires as of December 31, 2025. It is important that fee adjustments are reviewed on an annual basis to ensure that the related costs of providing the respective service are appropriately recovered.

The City's current policy dictates that fees and charges be reviewed and adjusted annually as follows:

- by the Ontario Consumer Price Index's third quarter from the prior year plus 1% for capital purposes, where appropriate;
- by a cumulative adjustment for past years where the fee is not adjusted by the Consumer Price Index in one or more years; and
- by an amount that will recover, at a minimum, respective service, administration, and capital costs, as well as costs for any other purpose, in any amount permitted under applicable law.

Analysis

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) is the accepted measure for the rate of inflation and continues to be the target of the Bank of Canada fiscal policy. The Ontario Consumer Price Index was 2.0% at the end of the third quarter of 2025. In cases where fees are being adjusted by an inflationary factor, an average escalation of 2% plus 1% for capital purposes, where applicable, has been applied, effective January 1, 2026. This is a reasonable proxy for recovering expected service costs and maintaining relative proportions of user fees and taxation subsidy and has been a consistent historical practice in response to the annual variability of the CPI measure. Some fees have been adjusted slightly more or less than this amount as a result of rounding in order to maintain even dollar amounts after tax for ease of cash handling or to support the constraints of respective cash collection equipment.

Fee changes

For ease of review, the sections referenced below provide detailed explanations for schedule fee changes other than the annual inflationary adjustment noted above. The majority of these adjustments reflect one of the following strategies:

- Maintaining fee levels where the charge is currently sufficient to cover the full cost of the good or service.
- Setting fees to reflect an appropriate market rate based on market analysis.
- Minimizing fee increases to encourage increased use.

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- Setting fees to support harmonization efforts or consistency of fees for similar services across different departments.
- Setting fees in accordance with Council-approved strategies.
- Addition of new fees, as required.

Schedule A - Administration

Finance and Property Taxation

- The fee for "Affidavit for pension proof of life and other non-profit housing matters" remains unchanged in order to support residents and tenants.

City Clerk's Office

- Document search fee is legislated resulting in no fee increase.
- No increase to the fees for copies or scans of large format drawings or for civil marriage solemnizations, as fees are sufficient to cover service costs.

Cemetery Fees

- No increase to fees for cornerstones, lot marking, internment rights transfers and repurchase fees, as fees are sufficient to cover service costs.
- No increase to fees for care & maintenance of markers (monuments), as these fees are set by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario.

Environment

- Adding three new Environmental Impact Assessment fees to appropriately recover service costs.

Schedule B – Museums

Tour Programs

- The Walking Tour fee has been discontinued, as the temporary service is no longer offered.

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Heritage Reference Materials

- Reduced the fee for “Volumes – Buildings of Architectural Significance” to encourage sale of the remaining inventory.

Schedule C - Grand Theatre

Regina Rosen Auditorium

- Venue rental fees have increased by greater than an inflationary adjustment to simplify pricing agreements; the new rate now includes the cost of the PA system, which was previously charged as a separate fee.
- An increase greater than an inflationary adjustment is being applied to rehearsal rental fees for commercial clients to align with market rent for similar sized venues; nonprofits/community groups have been increased by the inflationary adjustment only.

Baby Grand Auditorium

- An increase greater than an inflationary adjustment is being applied to rental fees for commercial clients to align with market rent for similar sized venues; nonprofits/community groups have been increased by the inflationary adjustment only.

Equipment and Staffing

- The “Full PA system” fee has been removed and added to the venue rental fees.
- The fee for “On-stage monitoring and console use” has been reduced to reflect the removal of the PA fees component.
- The “Weekly Rental” remains at two and a half times the single performance fee, excluding the PA system.
- Clarification for fees related to Materials/Supplies to include use of consumables as well as additional rental requirements.

Marketing Support

- An increase greater than the inflationary measure has been applied to the fees for Marketing Support for Commercial entities, to ensure appropriate recovery of related service costs.
- Marketing Support for Kingston Non-Profits (Artists) and Kingston Community Groups has been added as a new fee, based on 50% of the commercial fee.

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Schedule D - Recreation & Leisure

Council approved changes to the recreation fee structure, as part of [Report Number 25-149](#), in order to implement a 15% non-resident user fee/surcharge for recreation facility programming, room bookings and facility rentals for 2026, as well as a 72-hour registration delay for non-residents for recreation facility programming. These changes have been incorporated into the 2026 Fees and Charges By-Law, where applicable.

Fitness or Pool, All Inclusive Fit Pass, and All-Inclusive Racquet Sport Pass Memberships

- Fitness Locations updated to include the Boys and Girls Club Southeast.
- Boys and Girls Club Southeast operates for 10 months of year, so only monthly or six-month passes are available for that location.
- Family memberships have been updated to include cardio weight room unless age restriction applies.
- Fitness or Pool Memberships have added a new “Camp visit – group of 10 or more campers” fee in the child category to reflect this new service.

To right-size fees for fitness programs, the following changes have been made:

- For the following activities, a fee decrease or no increase was applied to fees to remain competitive with similar market rates:
 - Per visit & 12-visit - Gym or pool (youth & senior)
 - 1-month passes - Gym or pool (child)
 - 6-month - All Inclusive Racquet Sport Pass (youth & senior)
- Fee increases greater than an inflationary adjustment have been applied to the following fees to align with fees of similar membership offerings in the community:
 - Per day visit - Gym or pool (child, family)
 - 12-visit passes - Gym or pool (child)
 - 1-month passes - Gym or pool (adult, family)
 - 1-month - All Inclusive Fit Pass (adult, child, youth & senior, family)
 - 1-month - All Inclusive Racquet Sport Pass (adult, child, youth & senior)
 - 6-month - All Inclusive Racquet Sport Pass (child)
- Given the significant variance in fees for City-offered programs, increases to the following fees will be phased-in over a three-year period to better align with fees of comparable membership fees in the community:
 - 6-month & 12-month passes - Gym or pool (adult, child, youth & senior, family)

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- 12-month - All Inclusive Fit Pass (family)

Culligan Water Park

- Fees removed as facility will be closed for the 2026 season.

Other Fees

- Toonie swim, skate or gymnasium fee remains at the same.
- Camp swim rate per child is increasing to remain in line with the group rate for the same service.
- Fee for shower services has been removed as this service is no longer available at Artillery Park.

Events & Programs

- Fee increases greater than an inflationary adjustment will be applied to Public Skating per visit & 12-visit (adult, child, youth & senior, family) to ensure appropriate recovery of related service costs.

Artillery Park Programs

- The following fees have been added for new swim programs to be offered in 2026:
 - Life-saving Sport (8-week program)
 - Junior Lifeguard Club
 - Aquatics Bundle (Bronze medallion, Bronze Cross, National Lifeguard Certification)

Schedule E – Facility Rentals

Culligan Water Park fees removed as facility will be closed for the 2026 season.

Mobile Staging Rentals (SL100 and SL75) - new fees added to reflect discounts for additional days' rentals.

Schedule F - Rideaucrest Catering & Coffee Shop

The following fees remained the same as sufficient to recover related service costs:

- Plates (large, small)
- Utensils (knife, fork, spoon, Styrofoam cup, napkin, straw)

Schedule I – Sports Fields

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Sports Fields

- Confirmed the inclusion of a 10% capital surcharge on the rental of any outdoor rectangular and diamond sports fields.
- In 2025, all major, minor and tournament fees were updated to clarify that the fee was per field. A discount in fees was applied, to be phased out over a three-year period. A discount of 40% in 2025 has been reduced to 30% for 2026.

Schedule K – Marinas

Other Fees

- Increasing the fee for ice by greater than an inflationary adjustment, for ease of cash handling.

Schedule L - Airport

Landing of Aircraft

- “Minimum for Commercial Fixed-Wing” fee for commercial aircraft below 2,300 kilograms increased greater than an inflationary adjustment to align with fees charged at similar sized airports.

Passenger Facility

- The existing “Passenger facility (secured operations)” fee stayed the same to remain competitive.
- A new “Passenger facility (unsecured operations)” fee, based on 50% of the secured operations fee, has been added to support operations that do not utilize the secure portion of the terminal.

Surcharges

- No increase to the Avgas fuel and Turbine fuel surcharges as they are sufficient to recover related service costs.
- No increase has been applied to the Commercial Operations fee in order to remain competitive.

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Aircraft Parking

- An increase greater than an inflationary adjustment has been applied to the Monthly Parking fee for aircraft less than 2,000kg and aircraft between 2,000kg to 4,999kg, to align with other monthly parking rates.
- The fee for Annual Aircraft Parking has been removed. Aircraft owners will pay the monthly rate for the number of months that they require tiedowns.

Schedule M - Planning

Miscellaneous Fees

- Fees for photocopies or printing of documents – black and white, are remaining the same to be consistent with similar fees.

Tree Permit (removal/cutting) and Renewal

- New fee for Tree protection plan added; required when no trees are proposed for removal for building site. This fee is built into all other tree permit fees.

Development Application Review – Development Engineering

- No increase to the Plan of Subdivision deposits as they are sufficient to address risk

Schedule O - Parking

A comprehensive parking fee study, presented as part of [Report Number EITP-25-001](#), informed increases to parking fees in 2025 including increases to hourly parking rates for both on-street and parking lots and garages. As a result, the following fees will not change for 2026:

- On Street Parking - Meters and Pay and Display,
- Monthly Residential On-Street Permit rates,
- Hourly and flat rates for parking lots and parking garages, and
- Parking Lot Event Rates

Residential On Street Permits

- The Weekly Residential Visitor permit will increase greater than an inflationary adjustment for ease of payment due to rounding.

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Parking Lots

- The Ordnance Lot hourly rate fee has been removed as the lot is being used for permit parking only.

Parking Lot Permits

- The Doug Fluhrer Lot permit fee will increase greater than an inflationary adjustment to better align with other parking lot permit fees.

Schedule P - Solid Waste

Garbage

- Garbage Bag Tag fees will not increase in 2026 as fees are sufficient to recover related service costs.

Garbage and Organics Carts

- No change to the Automated cart size service or upsizing fees which began in Spring 2025.
- New fees added to recover Auto Cart replacement costs.

Source Separated Organics and Composting

- The fee for Backyard composters has been removed as these items will no longer be offered.

Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional Users of Municipal and Contracted Compost Sites

- The per tonne fee for compost has been removed, as the city will no longer operate a weigh scale as of January 1, 2026. Compostable yard waste and brush will be charged by type and size of vehicle: passenger vehicle, pickup truck, commercial van, truck, or trailer.

Recycling

- Recycling fees for blue and grey boxes, and commercial user fees have been removed as the services are no longer provided by the city.

Recycling - Special Events

- All special event fees have been removed as these services are no longer provided by the city.
- A new rental fee for OSKAR, the City's On-Site Kingston Area Recycler was added to recover the costs per event.

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Miscellaneous

- The “Use of weight scale” fee was removed as the service is no longer offered.

Schedule Q – Transit

Kingston Transit fares normally increase every three years; increases were made in 2025 and are expected to increase again in 2028.

Schedule R - Building Permits**Sewage System Permit**

- No increase to Sewage System Permit fees as they are sufficient to recover respective service costs and to ensure consistency in fee structures.

Schedule S - Licensing and By-Law Enforcement**Animal Registration**

- No increase to fees for animal registration to encourage licensing activities.

Business Licenses

- In November 2025, Council approved recommendations outlined in [Report Number AP-25-001](#) with respect to business licenses, based on a comprehensive review of the business licensing by-law. These changes included the removal of two business license classifications - Alarm Installation/Alarm Monitoring and Bill Posters - and the addition of two new business license classifications - Scrap Metal Dealer Establishment and Vapour Product Retail Establishment. Recommendations also included redefining and renaming several other business license classifications to better align with current regulations and to create a more streamlined process for managing these types of applications.

As part of this review, staff also undertook a comprehensive evaluation of fees across all reclassified business types. Through this process, some fee structures were standardized so that each classification has a consistent user fee based on the related staff effort involved in the respective licensing process. This realignment has resulted in an overall decrease in certain fees and increases to others with some fee changes being phased in over two years. Changes to business license classifications and proposed fees, as outlined in Exhibit E to Report Number AP-25-001, have been incorporated into the 2026 Fees and Charges By-Law.

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- No increase to following fees to remain competitive:
 - Short-term Rental Brokerage - Tiers 1 & 2, and
 - Specific location sale: Class 3
- Council recently approved the transfer of the administration and enforcement of the Transportation Networking Companies (“TNC”) By-Law from the Kingston Area Taxi Commission back to the City, effective January 1, 2026. Related licensing fees are included in the 2026 Fees and Charges By-Law, adjusted by an inflationary increase, to ensure appropriate cost recovery.

Administrative Fees

- No increase to the fee for Property Standards/Yard Re-inspections (after first inspection to confirm compliance of any order).
- Photocopy copies of document fees remain the same to be consistent with similar fees.
- New fee added to recover external non-violent intervention train-the-trainer costs.

Existing Policy/By-Law

[Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 PART XII, Section 391](#) authorizes a municipality to impose fees or charges on persons, (a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; (b) for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and (c) for the use of its property including property under its control.

[City of Kingston By-Law Number 2025-6](#), “A By-Law to Establish Fees and Charges to be Collected by The Corporation of the City of Kingston”, as amended. This By-Law provides authorization in a consolidated fashion for the purposes of establishing fees and charges in a fiscal year.

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City of Kingston By-Law Number 2026–XX

A By-Law to repeal City of Kingston By-Law Number 2025-06, "Fees & Charges By-Law, 2025" in its entirety, and to establish "Fees & Charges By-Law, 2026"

Whereas:

The *City* is a single-tier municipality incorporated pursuant to an order made under section 25.2 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45.

The powers of a municipality must be exercised by its council (*Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the "***Municipal Act, 2001***"), s. 5 (1)).

A municipal power must be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 5 (3)).

A by-law respecting a matter may:

- (a) regulate or prohibit respecting the matter;
- (b) require persons to do things respecting the matter; and
- (c) provide for a system of licences respecting the matter (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 8 (3)).

A single tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 10 (1)).

A single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting:

- (a) economic, social and environmental well-being of the municipality, including respecting climate change;
- (b) health, safety and well-being of persons;
- (c) protection of persons and property, including consumer protection;
- (d) structures, including fences and signs; and
- (e) business licensing (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 10 (2)).

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A municipality may delegate its powers and duties under the *Municipal Act, 2001* to a person or body subject to the restrictions set out in Part II of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (s. 23.1 (1)).

Sections 9, 10 and 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorize a municipality to impose *fees* on persons,

- (a) for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it;
- (b) for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and
- (c) for the use of its property including property under its control (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 391 (1)).

A municipality may impose a *fee* for capital costs related to services or activities on persons not receiving an immediate benefit from the services or activities but who will receive a benefit at some later point in time (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 391 (2)).

The costs included in a *fee* may include costs incurred by the municipality related to administration, enforcement and the establishment, acquisition and replacement of capital assets (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 391 (3)).

The *City* incurs additional costs related to administration and enforcement when *fees* are due and unpaid.

Fees imposed by a municipality on a person constitute a debt of the person to the municipality (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 398 (1)).

The treasurer of a municipality may add *fees* imposed by the municipality to the tax roll for the following property in the municipality and collect them in the same manner as municipal taxes:

- (a) in the case of *fees* for the supply of a service or thing to a property, the property to which the service or thing was supplied; and
- (b) in all other cases, any property for which all of the owners are responsible for paying the *fees* (*Municipal Act, 2001*, s. 398 (2)).

The council of a municipality, by by-law, may establish a tariff of *fees* for the processing of applications made in respect of applications made in respect of planning matters, which tariff must be designed to meet only the anticipated costs to the municipality or to

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a committee of adjustment or land division committee constituted by the council of the municipality or to the planning board in respect of the procession of each type of application provided for in the tariff (*Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, s. 69 (1)).

The council of a municipality may pass by-laws applicable to the matters for which and in the area in which the municipality has jurisdiction for the enforcement of the *Building Code Act* requiring the payment of *fees* and prescribing the amount of the *fees*:

- (a) on the application for and on issuance of permits;
- (b) for maintenance inspections; and
- (c) for providing documentation, records or other information.

The council of a municipality may by by-law fix its reasonable administrative fees to be paid to the municipality in relation to proceedings under the *Line Fences Act* (*Line Fences Act*, s. 17).

Council considers it necessary and desirable for the public to impose *fees* on persons.

Therefore, *council* enacts:

1 INTERPRETATION

1.1 This by-law may be cited as the *Fees & Charges By-Law, 2026*.

1.2 In this by-law:

“annual CPI change” means the percentage change between the Ontario Consumer Price Index for the third quarter of the calendar year that is one year before the year in which the adjustment is being made and the third quarter of the Ontario Consumer Price Index that is two years before the year in which the adjustment is being made;

“City” means The Corporation of the City of Kingston;

“clerk” means the individual appointed by the *City* as clerk or the *clerk’s* designate;

“collection agency” means a collection agency registered by the Registrar under the *Collection and Debt Settlement Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. C.14;

“council” means the council of the *City*;

"**director**" means the director of a *City* department;

"**fee**" means a fee or charge imposed by the *City* under sections 9, 10 or 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*;

"**Municipal Act, 2001**" means the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25;

"**schedule**" means a schedule to this by-law;

"**treasurer**" means the individual appointed by the *City* as treasurer or the *treasurer's* designate.

1.3 For the purposes of interpreting this by-law:

- (a) a reference to any legislation, regulation, or by-law or to a provision thereof includes a reference to any legislation, regulation or by-law enacted, made or passed in substitution thereof or amendment thereof;
- (b) any reference to legislation or by-laws includes all of the regulations made thereunder;
- (c) "include", "includes" and "including" indicate that the subsequent list is not exhaustive; and
- (d) to "provide" a service or activity includes to do the service or activity.

1.4 This by-law will not be interpreted as exempting any person from the requirement to comply with any other *City* by-law or federal or provincial legislation. In the event of conflict between the provisions of this by-law and any other *City* by-law, the provision that establishes the higher standard of health, safety and well-being of persons and protection of persons will apply.

2 ADMINISTRATION

2.1 The *treasurer* is responsible for the administration of this by-law.

2.2 The *treasurer* may rectify minor administrative oversights in respect of a *fee* set out in a *schedule*.

2.3 Where this by-law provides that the *treasurer* may do an act, it may be done by an individual authorized by the *treasurer* to do the act.

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- 2.4 The *treasurer* may make *regulations* prescribing when a *fee* or class of *fees* becomes due and payable and the manner in which a *fee* or class of *fees* must be paid.
- 2.5 The *treasurer* may waive a *fee* in accordance with the *City's Waiver of Fees Policy* or its successor.
- 2.6 The *treasurer* may authorize one or more *collection agencies* to collect *fees* that are due and unpaid on behalf of the *City*, including by purchasing those debts and collecting them.

3 FEES

- 3.1 This by-law imposes, establishes, fixes and requires the payment of the *fees* set out in the column with a *fee* amount in a *schedule*:
- (a) for the corresponding service or activity provided or done by or on behalf of the *City*;
 - (b) for the corresponding costs payable by the *City* for a service or activity provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and
 - (c) for the corresponding use of the *City's* property including property under the *City's* control;

set out in the column describing the service, activity or use of *City* property in that *schedule*.

- 3.2 This by-law imposes an additional *fee* in the form of an interest charge on *fees* or any portion of *fees* that are due and unpaid at the rate of 1 ¼ percent per month for each month or fraction of a month during with the *fees* that are due remain unpaid.
- 3.3 The *City* will collect harmonized value-added taxes on all *fees* in accordance with the *Excise Tax Act*, R.S.C., 1985, c. E-15.

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3.4 Subject to any *regulation* made by the *treasurer*, *fees* are due and payable at the time:

- (a) the person requests that the *City* provide the service or activity;
- (b) the person requests to use the *City's* property;
- (c) the person makes the application in respect of a planning matter;
- (d) the person makes the application under the *Building Code Act*;
- (e) the person requests the maintenance inspection under the *Building Code Act*;
- (f) the person requests that the *City* provide documentation, records or other information; or
- (g) as otherwise agreed to in writing by the person and the *City*;

or, if the person did not make such a request or application, *fees* are due and payable at the time the *City* provides the service, activity, maintenance inspection, documentation, records or other information, or the *City* permits the person to use its property.

3.5 The *treasurer* may add *fees* to the *City's* tax roll for the following property in the City of Kingston and collect them in the same manner as municipal taxes:

- (a) in the case of *fees* for the supply of a service or thing to a property, the property to which the service or thing was supplied; and
- (b) in all other cases, any property for which all of the owners are responsible for paying the *fees*.

3.6 If the *treasurer* adds *fees* to the *City's* tax roll under a property under section 3.2, that amount, including interest:

- (a) may be collected in the same manner as taxes on the property;
- (b) may be recovered with costs as a debt due to the *City* from the assessed owner of the property at the time the *fee* was added to the tax roll and from any subsequent owner of the property or party of it;

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- (c) is a special lien on the property in the same manner as are taxes under subsection 349 (3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and
 - (d) may be included in the cancellation price under Part XI of the *Municipal Act, 2001* in the same manner as are taxes on the property.
- 3.7 Each year, every *director* must review and determine or adjust the *fees* for which the *director* is responsible in accordance with sections 3.8 and 3.9.
- 3.8 Subject to section 3.9, a *director* may generally adjust the amount of a *fee* on January 1 of each year by the *annual CPI change*, plus one per cent for capital costs related to the service or activity.
- 3.9 When determining or adjusting the amount of a *fee*, a *director* must ensure that:
- (a) there is a connection between the *fee* and the cost of the service or activity provided or done on behalf of the *City*, including:
 - (i) capital costs, operating costs, administration costs and any other costs related to the service or activity; and
 - (ii) any such costs offset by other revenue, including taxes, grants or subsidies; and
 - (b) the *fee* is reasonable, including relative to prices for similar services or activities in Ontario provided by persons other than the *City*.

4 GENERAL

- 4.1 In the event of a conflict between a fee or charge made under any other by-law and a *fee* made under this by-law, the *fee* made under this by-law prevails.
- 4.2 This by-law will come into force and take effect on January 2, 2026.
- 4.3 City of Kingston By-Law Number 2025-06, "Fees & Charges By-Law, 2025", is hereby repealed in its entirety, effective January 2, 2026.

 - (iv) an application to adjust a lot boundary or facilitate a simple lot addition; or
 - (v) an application for consent to a power of sale or mortgage; or
 - (vi) an application for consent to a lease in excess of 21 years; or
 - (vii) an application for validation of title.
- Dormant Files that have remained inactive for three years will be deemed closed. In the event that a request is made to reactivate a closed file, the applicant shall pay the full existing fee for planning services regardless of any fees paid in the past.
- Engineering Review Fees will be charged as per the Engineering Fee Schedule according to the individual application requirements and payment is required at the time of application submission.
- Legal Fees will be invoiced at the time documentation is executed.
- Peer Review - Fee to be paid by the applicant prior to staff authorizing the consultant to commence work.

- All planning fees, engineering fees and legal fees would be waived for not-for-profit housing providers that submit development proposals which include affordable units. All planning fees, engineering fees and legal fees would be waived for private affordable housing development units at 80% or less of Canadian Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) rental rate. - Gross floor area of the proposed work is to be measured to the outer face of exterior walls (excluding residential attached garages) and to the centre line of party walls, firewalls, or demising walls.
- In the case of interior finishes, alterations or renovations, area of proposed work is the actual space receiving the work, e.g., tenant suite.
- Mechanical penthouses and floors, mezzanines, lofts, habitable attics, and interior balconies are to be included in all floor area calculations.
- Except for interconnected floor spaces, no deductions are made for openings within the floor area (e.g., stairs, elevators, escalators, shafts, ducts, etc.).
- Unfinished basements for single detached dwellings, semi-detached dwellings and townhouses are not included in the floor area.
- Where there is no floor or walls, the gross floor area shall be the greatest horizontal area of the structure (birds eye view).
- Where demolition of partitions or alterations to existing ceilings are part of an alteration or renovation permit, no additional charge is applicable.
- Corridors, lobbies, washrooms, lounges, etc. are to be included and classified according to the major occupancy for the floor area on which they are located.
- The occupancy categories in this schedule correspond with the major occupancy classifications in the Ontario Building Code. For multiple occupancy floor areas, the permit fees for each of the applicable occupancy categories may be used, except where an occupancy category is less than 10% of the floor area.
- The minimum fee for all permits is \$152.00, when applicable.
