By-Law to Amend City of Kingston By-Law Number 2023–9, A By-Law for the Appointment of Statutory Officials of The Corporation of the City of Kingston

Whereas:

The Corporation of the City of Kingston (the “**City**”) is a single-tier municipality incorporated pursuant to an order made under section 25.2 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45.

Subsection 5 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the “**Municipal Act, 2001**”) provides that the powers of a municipality must be exercised by its council.

Subsection 5 (3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides that a municipal power must be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise.

Subsection 6 (1) of the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O. 1997, c. 4 provides that if a fire department is established for the whole or part of a municipality or for more than one municipality, the Council of the municipality shall appoint a fire chief.

Subsection 3(2) of the Building Code Act, 1992, S.O. 1992, c. 23 provides that the Council of a municipality shall appoint a chief building official and such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of the Building Code Act in which the municipality has jurisdiction.

Subsection 1.1 of R.R.O 1990, Reg. 738 provides that the clerk of a local municipality is authorized to solemnize marriages under the authority of licence.

On December 20, 2022, council for the *City* enacted *City of Kingston By-Law Number 2023–9, “A By-Law for the Appointment of Statutory Officials of The Corporation of the City of Kingston”*.

By-Law Number 2023-9 delegated authority to the clerk to prepare amendments to Schedule “A” of *By-Law Number 2023-9* to reflect personnel changes and to place such amending by-laws on the council agenda for all three readings

Council for the *City* considers it necessary and desirable for the public to amend *City of*

Therefore, council enacts:

1. Amendment

1.1 | *City of Kingston By-Law Number 2023–9* is amended as follows:

- (a) Schedule A, Section 10 is amended by deleting the words “Jeff Gurnsey” and substituting the words “Jacob Byrnes”.
- (b) Schedule A, Section 14 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

“Kevin Donaldson is hereby appointed Fire Chief of the City pursuant to 6(1) of the Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997, S.O., c.4.”
- (c) Schedule A, Section 20 is amended by deleting the words “Stephanie Trudel”. |

2. Coming into Force

2.1 This by-law will come into force and take effect on the day it is passed.
